Background

NGGWS

The Hon'ble Prime Minister had mandated the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG) to hold virtual conferences/webinars with District Collectors and other Officers over the next 12 months. A specific themes/sector may be taken up in each month, in which past award winners since the inception of the Scheme under that sector be invited to present their experiences.

In his address on the occasion of Civil Services Day, 2022, the Hon'ble Prime Minister suggested that training institutes should conduct virtual Sessions of 1-1.5 Hours with the award winners as the Lead Speakers, to disseminate the best practices.

Accordingly, DARPG and NCGG jointly conducted 13 National Good Governance Webinars, one webinar a month on different themes, on the last Friday of every month, over the year 2022-2023. The purpose of the Webinars is to highlight and disseminate the best practices and sharing of experiences of the award winning institution to facilitate replication by other States/Districts.

Thirteen (13) Webinars have been held in the last thirteen months from April, 2022- April, 2023, on the PM award winning initiatives on the themes 'Improving Public Service Delivery'; 'Health'; 'Aspirational District programme'; 'Public Grievance Redressal', 'Environment', 'Public Participation (Jan Bhagidari) through Swachh Bharat Mission', Innovations at District, State and Centre levels, 'Jal/Water Management' and 'Namami Gange'.

These webinars were attended by about 1000 officials from Ministries/ Departments, State Governments and District Collectors. Given the encouraging response, it has been decided to continue the initiative of organizing the National Good Governance Webinar Series in the year 2023-2024. For the year 2023-24, a total of twelve Webinars have been planned.

In this backdrop of the National Good Governance Webinar Series, DARPG, in collaboration with NCGG, has convened the 16th Webinar on PM's Award Winning Initiatives under the theme "Innovation - District" on July 28th 2023.

Overview

NGGWS

The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances has initiated a unique initiative of organizing National Good Governance Webinar Series on a monthly basis from April 2022, which has been very popular amongst practicing administrators. Very large participation has been observed in the 13 Webinars held upto April 2023. The Hon'ble Vice President of India released the compendium of the National Good Governance Webinar Series 2022-23 on 20th April 2023 in the inaugural session of Civil Services Day events 2023. It has been decided to continue the initiative of organizing the National Good Governance Webinar Series.

The awardees present their exemplary work in these National Webinars, to highlight the best practices adopted by the award-winning initiatives for replication by other States/Districts. Doing so would also infuse a new spirit and enthusiasm among administrators and other stakeholders involved in the implementation of different government programmes. These webinars covering Award Winning Initiatives help in broadening of skills, dissemination of best practices as well as in replication of best practices.

A total of twelve Webinars have been planned (14th – 25th Webinar) from May 2023 to April 2024, one Webinar a month on the last Friday of the month, on different themes under the good governance initiative that have been felicitated with the Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration. Webinars would cover multiple areas like Health, Education Sports, Har Ghar Jal, Aspirational Districts Programme, Innovations, One District One Product (ODOP), PMSVANIDHI Yojna etc., wherein the initiatives have bagged the award for their exemplary work. The webinar series are fully documented.

Concept

Black Rice in Chandauli, Uttar Pradesh

In June 2018, backed by the District Administration, Chandauli - known as Uttar Pradesh's rice hub - saw the inaugural cultivation of chemical-free black rice. The venture aimed to boost farmers' earnings and involved 30 farmers across 10 hectares, yielding 300 quintals of crop. The success story continued into 2019-20, as 400 farmers dedicated 250 hectares to black rice, reaping 8000 quintals. To facilitate trade, the "Chandauli Kala Chaval Krishak Samiti" was formed under District Administration's guidance, uniting cultivators. The premium branding allowed the sale of this unique product at Rs. 300/kg, in stark contrast to the usual Rs. 30-50/kg for common rice. Consequently, farmer income per hectare surged from Rs. 54,532 to Rs. 2,55,500. The District Administration supported the Samiti in securing a Collective Mark, Packaging Design, and FSSAI certification. With export demand on the rise, farmers witnessed a substantial income hike compared to prior years. Looking ahead, the District Administration intends to transform the "Chandauli Kala Chawal Krishak Samiti" into a Farmers Producers Organization (FPO).

Speaker - Mr. Navneet Singh Chahal

Mr. Navneet Singh Chahal, the District Magistrate of Agra, brings a wealth of experience and expertise to his role. An Indian Administrative Service officer of the 2011 batch, he hails from Panipat, Haryana. His educational journey includes a B.E. in Electrical Engineering from PEC Chandigarh, PGDBM in Marketing & Finance from MDI Gurgaon, and a Masters in Management (Finance) from ESCP-EAP Paris, France. Notably, he was honored with the Prime Minister Award for Excellence in Public Administration in April 2022.

With a diverse range of postings over the years, including Chief Development Officer in Meerut and Jhansi, and Collector roles in Chandauli, Mathura, and now Agra since September 2022, Mr. Chahal has consistently demonstrated dedication and leadership.

Operation Parivartan in Solapur, Maharashtra

This initiative serves as a paradigm-shifting movement aimed at transforming the lives of the population in Maharashtra's Solapur district, previously entrenched in the illicit liquor trade. Through a transformative endeavor, a shift towards alternative livelihoods was orchestrated, replacing their involvement in liquor-related activities. This effort, backed by research-driven decisions, demonstrated successful integration of marginalized groups into society, particularly emphasizing women's empowerment. Operating with a zero-budget and holistic approach, the project effectively revamped the perception of law enforcement, portraying them as enablers rather than adversaries. This replicable model curtails illicit liquor production by 75-80%, mitigating associated risks like mass poisonings. It enabled dignified livelihoods for marginalized individuals, reframing their social status and reducing crime, conflicts, and violence related to the illegal liquor trade.

Speaker - Mrs. Tejaswi Satpute

Mrs. Tejaswi Satpute, currently serving as the Deputy Commissioner of Police in Mumbai, embodies a dynamic and accomplished law enforcement professional. With a distinguished career path in the Indian Police Service, she has consistently demonstrated a remarkable commitment to public service and innovative governance. Tejaswi's leadership has seen her steer large police establishments with strategic prowess, spearheading transformative initiatives like the one-time, one-place recruitment drive, Operation Parivartan, and unique welfare programs. Her expertise encompasses conflict resolution, community-oriented policing, and modernizing law enforcement practices. Notably recognized with prestigious awards, Tejaswi Satpute is a beacon of positive change and excellence in her field.

Session - I

1st Session – ‘Black Rice Initiative in District Chandauli, Uttar Pradesh’ – by **Mr. Navneet Singh Chahal**, District Magistrate, Agra

The Black Rice Initiative in Chandauli District, spearheaded by Shri Navneet Singh Chahal, the then District Magistrate, Chandauli, presently, District Magistrate of Agra, has been a revolutionary step towards boosting farmer's income, diversifying crop patterns, and increasing agricultural exports. This report highlights the key points presented by Shri Navneet Singh Chahal during the webinar on Innovation - District, focusing on the implementation strategy, outcomes achieved, and future expansion plans.

The primary goal of the Black Rice Initiative was to significantly enhance farmer's income by encouraging the cultivation of high-value crops like black rice. This initiative aimed to offer a viable alternative to traditional crops, enabling farmers to earn more from their agricultural endeavors.

The government set ambitious targets to increase black rice cultivation and improve farmer's income. To support the initiative, substantial budget provisions were allocated to facilitate farmers with quality seeds, modern farming techniques, and necessary infrastructure.

The Black Rice Initiative aimed to promote diversification in agriculture by encouraging farmers to shift towards cultivating high-value crops, such as black rice. This diversification not only reduces the dependency on traditional crops but also opens up new market opportunities.

The implementation strategy involved engaging with farmers, local agricultural experts, and other stakeholders to understand their needs and challenges. Training sessions, workshops, and awareness campaigns were conducted to educate farmers about the benefits of cultivating black rice.

The initiative was rolled out in two key phases:

a) Pilot Phase (Kharif 2018):

During the pilot phase, the focus was on selecting a group of enthusiastic farmers to cultivate black rice. They were provided with technical assistance, financial support, and access to modern agricultural technologies.

b) Implementation Phase (Kharif 2019):

Following the success of the pilot phase, the implementation phase was launched to extend black rice cultivation to a larger group of farmers. The initiative gained momentum, attracting more farmers to participate.



The Black Rice Initiative received extensive promotion through various media channels, agricultural fairs, and trade shows. As the nutritional benefits and unique appearance of black rice garnered attention, the demand for this crop surged, creating export potential.

To harness the export potential, collaboration with the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) was established. This partnership enabled access to international markets, thereby expanding the scope of black rice exports.

The successful collaboration with APEDA facilitated the export of black rice to international markets, with notable success in Australia. The premium quality of Chandauli's black rice received an overwhelming response from Australian consumers, paving the way for further exports.

Buoyed by the achievements, the initiative entered the scale-up phase during Kharif 2020. The scale-up phase aimed to expand black rice cultivation to cover larger areas and engage more farmers across the district.

The resounding success of the Black Rice Initiative in Chandauli encouraged other districts within the state to adopt a similar approach. The model also gained recognition at the national level, inspiring other states to replicate this innovative agricultural strategy.

Navneet Singh Chahal's groundbreaking Black Rice Initiative propels farmers' earnings, agri-diversification, and exports. Strategic planning, APEDA collaboration, and execution led to its impressive success. Replicating this model nationwide could revolutionize agriculture and empower farmers.


Mrs. Tejaswi Satpute, the Deputy Commissioner of Police at HQ2, Mumbai, delivered an insightful presentation on the groundbreaking "Operation Parivartan" initiative during a webinar on Innovation - District. The initiative was launched to address the pervasive issue of illicit liquor in Solapur, Maharashtra. This report provides an in-depth analysis of the key points discussed in her presentation, highlighting the problem, the comprehensive solution, its qualitative impact, governance, media coverage, and the awards and achievements garnered by the initiative.

Operation Parivartan is a multifaceted initiative aimed at combating the menace of illicit liquor in the region of Solapur, Maharashtra. Furthermore, Operation Parivartan sought to create awareness among the public about the dangers of consuming illicit liquor. Through various educational campaigns and awareness programs, the initiative aimed to empower citizens to make informed decisions and discourage the demand for illegal alcohol.

Operation Parivartan received extensive media coverage, which further bolstered its impact and reach. The presentation highlighted the media's role in bringing attention to the issue of illicit liquor and disseminating information about the initiative's progress and achievements. The positive coverage generated public support, fostering a sense of collective responsibility in combating the menace of illegal alcohol.

Mrs. Tejaswi Satpute proudly shared the accolades and recognition received by Operation Parivartan for its exceptional contributions. The initiative's efforts in curbing the illicit liquor trade and transforming lives earned it several awards from governmental and non-governmental organizations. These achievements served as a testament to the dedication and effectiveness of the initiative and motivated the team to continue their impactful work.

In conclusion, Mrs. Tejaswi Satpute's presentation on Operation Parivartan provided valuable insights into the successful approach taken to combat the problem of illicit liquor in Solapur, Maharashtra. 




Chandauli Black Rice Initiative




Farmers' Income


Farm households with income below poverty line



Ratio of income per non agriculture worker to income per cultivator




Distribution of the workforce across economic sectors







► Illicit Liquor is one of the most critical problems in the Solapur district

► Existed since the pre-independence period, increased since few decades

► Not only harmed the health of several people in previous incidences but identified as a root cause for social conflict and criminal activities in the state and country

► Majority historically marginalised and denotified communities involved

Illicit liquor in this context is a handmade illicit liquor manufactured on raw dens which is hazardous to health, consumed mostly by low-income groups.





Identifying Hotspots and Raiding Dens in short period of intervals


- ▶ Total 56 hotspots of manufacturing and 102 hotspots of sale have been identified in the district
- ▶ The interval between two raids on dens have been shortened from 60 days to 15 days to 3 days to break the cycle of profit.
- ▶ Dedicated responsibilities have been allocated to police officers to carry raids after every three days: Making business highly unprofitable





Industrial sewing machines were made available to them through loans from Lead Bank. Companies like Apex Garments and Jay Garments came forward to give them initial orders. The workplace was made available through the CSR of Balaji ammies. The women who used to produce illicit liquor are now busy in manufacturing shirts, school uniforms, aprons and several other products. They have proudly named their small unit "Parivartan Udyog Samuh".
